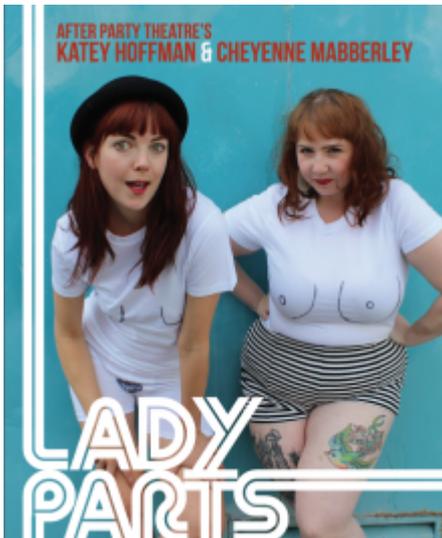
We are looking for individuals, collectives and companies to get involved and direct their own piece to spark conversations around climate change.

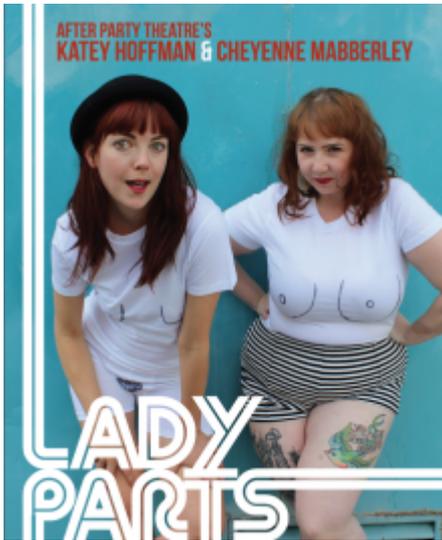
